AFSG-1 Ground Power Unit  This project involves restoring this DC power supply unit (GPU) to working order in partnership with the École nationale d'aérotechnique as part of student activities.  The amount provided allows the acquisition of all the parts and components necessary to restore the GPU to working order.	\$ 2,500
Transport and Storage Carts  Realization of two transport and storage carts for the tail (projects GSE02 and GSE03) and the wingtip tanks (projects GSE02 and GSE04) of our Avro CF-100 Canuck # 100760 designed by ÉTS students. This will be achieved within the framework of educational projects of a technical school.  The planned amount includes the acquisition of all the raw materials, parts and components necessary for the realization of the project.	\$ 3,000
Wingtip Tanks Refurbishment  Avro CF-100 Canuck #100760 wingtip tanks refurbishment to display status. This will be done within the framework of educational projects of a technical school. Tail Assembly Refurbishment  Avro CF-100 Canuck #100760 tail assembly refurbishment to display status. This will be done within the framework of educational projects of a technical school. Transport and Storage Cart  Realization of a transport and storage cart for the wings of our Avro CF-100 Canuck #100760 (projects GSE05) designed by ÉTS students. The planned amount includes the acquisition of all the raw materials, parts and components necessary for the realization of the project.	\$ 7,000
Transport and Storage Trailer  Realization of a transport and storage trailer for the fuselage of our Avro CF-100 Canuck #100760 (projects GSE06) designed by ÉTS students. This will be achieved within the framework of educational projects of a technical school. The planned amount includes the acquisition of all the raw materials, parts and components necessary for the realization of the project.	\$ 10,000
Transport and Support Jig  Realization of the jig intended to support the fuselage of the Avro CF-100 Canuck #100760 (GSE05 project) designed by ÉTS students. This will be done within the framework of educational projects of a technical school. Note that the main elements making up the jig can be used later for other projects.  The planned amount includes the acquisition of all the raw materials, parts and components necessary for the realization of the project.	\$ 40,000
