Pierre Gillard elected Chairman *ad interim* of Québec Aerospace Museum's Board of Directors.

Saint-Hubert, QC, August 24, 2022.

The special General Assembly of members of the Québec Aerospace Museum (QAM) held on August 21st, 2022 elected Mr. Pierre Gillard as Chairman of its Board of Directors. He thus succeeds Mr. Kym Abel, who recently resigned, and occupies this position temporarily, the time to find a new candidate to fill the function. Simultaneously, and still on a temporary basis, he agreed to take on the role of CEO of the organization. In addition, he retains his position as secretary of the Board of Directors.

Pierre Gillard is one of the three founding members of the QAM and teaches at the École nationale d'aérotechnique in Saint-Hubert as a professor in the Avionics Department. He also holds aircraft maintenance engineer and commercial helicopter pilot licenses.

For his part, Kym Abel will continue to be involved in the development of the QAM. Indeed, with our member Cyril Chambon, he becomes Funding Delegate, a so important task within our organization.
